Israel hits Hamas leaders in Qatar amid truce talks

Military says Hamas orchestrating war struck with 'precise munitions, added intelligence'

DUBAI

ISRAEL launched a strike on Hamas' leadership in Qatar on Tuesday as they discussed a US proposal for a ceasefire in Gaza, officials said. It marked a stunning extension of Israel's campaign against the militant group and risked upending negotiations aimed at winding down the war and releasing Israeli hostages.

Black smoke rose over the skyline of the Qatari capital, Doha, with authorities there acknowledging the strike. It wasn't immediately clear if anyone was hurt in the attack.

The assault marks the second time the energy-rich nation has been directly attacked in the nearly two years of war that have gripped the wider Middle East since Hamas' October 7 attack on southern Israel. Qatar has served as a key negotiator in efforts to end the conflict. It also calls into question whether any negotiations immediately will continue. UN Secretary General Antonio Guterres condemned the attack, saying "all parties must work towards achieving a permanent ceasefire, not destroying it." Israeli military hinted the air force carried out the strike, as Qatar Airways flights continued landing and a Qatari jet took off on patrol. Israeli officials have sent mixed

messages throughout the war, relying on Qatari mediation while also questioning its willingness to put pressure on Hamas. In a statement after the attack, which didn't specifically name Qatar, Israel's military said Hamas' leaders were "directly responsible for the brutal massacre, and have been orchestrating and managing the war against the State of Israel."

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu said he ordered the strikes targeting Hamas leaders in Doha, following a deadly shooting in Jerusalem a day earlier claimed by the Palestinian militant group. "Yesterday, following the deadly attacks in Jerusalem and Gaza, Prime Minister Netanyahu instructed all security agencies to prepare for the possibility of targeting Hamas leaders," said a joint statement from Netanyahu and Defence Minister Israel Katz.

It said they are increasingly optimistic that Hamas' leadership was killed after 10 bombs were dropped on the site, noting that Hamas has tried to conceal the loss of its leaders in the past. The Israelis said it used "precise munitions and additional intelligence" in the strike, without elaborating.

Qatar condemned what it referred to as a "cowardly Israeli attack" on Hamas' political headquarters in Doha. AP/AFP



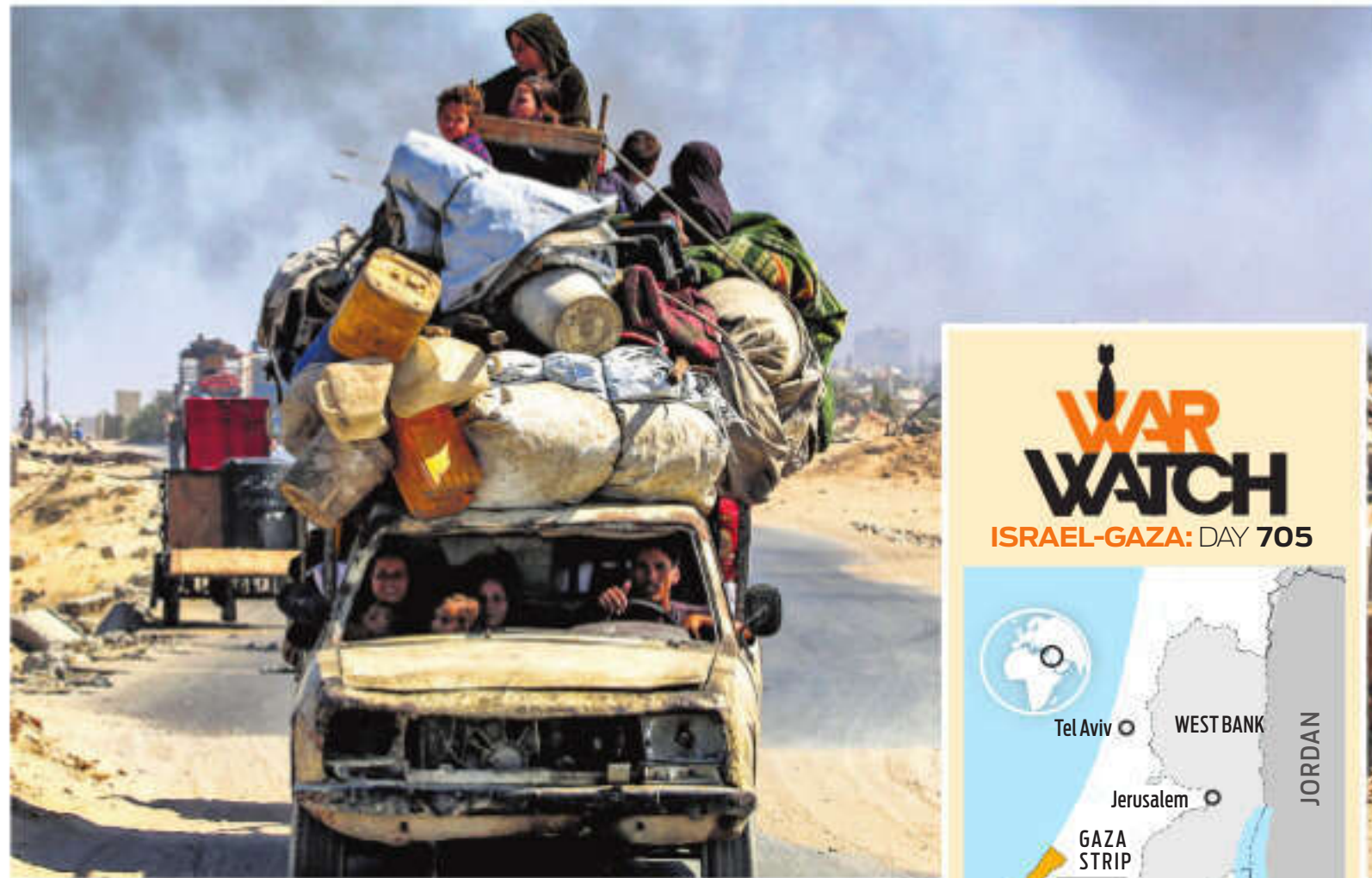

Pro-Palestinian protesters rally at London arms fair

London: Pro-Palestinian protesters gathered on Tuesday outside a major arms fair in London as it opened without the presence of Israeli government officials because of tension between Britain and Israel over the Gaza conflict. Police watched as around 300 protesters waved Palestinian flags and held up placards including one reading "UK: Stop arming Israel. Stop the Gaza Genocide." Three protesters were arrested for assaults on police officers, London's Metropolitan Police said.

Gaza aid flotilla reports boat strike in Tunisia

Tunis: An international activist group seeking to deliver aid to Gaza on a flotilla says one of its boats was hit by what it believes was a drone while docked in Tunisia. Tunisian authorities denied a drone was involved and said they are investigating a fire in a life jacket aboard the boat. The Global Smud Flotilla said in a statement overnight that a vessel known as the "Family Boat," traveling under a Portuguese flag, "was struck by a drone," but that no one aboard was hurt. Group's video showed a flash hitting a boat, sparking a fire.

Netanyahu tells residents of Gaza City to 'leave now'

ISRAEL'S military warned Gaza City residents on Tuesday to evacuate ahead of its planned offensive to take control of what it portrays as Hamas' last remaining stronghold and where hundreds of thousands of people remain struggling under conditions of famine.

The warning came hours before Israel launched a strike targeting Hamas' leaders in

Qatar, officials said, intensifying its campaign against the militant group and endangering negotiations over ending the war in Gaza.

The warnings directed at Gaza City were the first calling for a full evacuation. Until now, the military has only told specific sections of the northern city to evacuate ahead of operations or strikes. Associated Press reporters saw lines of cars and trucks leaving, more



Michigan court drops case against fake electors

LANSING

A Michigan judge dismissed criminal charges on Tuesday against a group of people who were accused of attempting to falsely certify President Donald Trump as the winner of the 2020 election in the battleground state, a major blow to prosecutors as similar cases in four other states have been muddled with setbacks.

District Court Judge Kristen D Simmons said in a court hearing that the 15 Republicans accused will not face trial. The case has dragged through the courts since Michigan Attorney General Dana Nessel, a Democrat, announced the charges over two years ago.

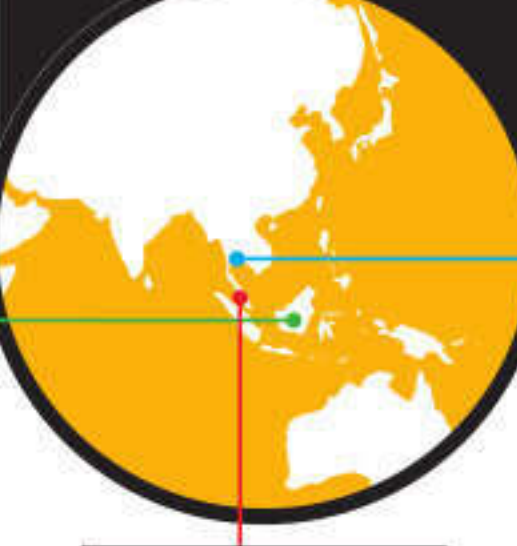
Simmons said she saw no intent to commit fraud in the defendants' actions. Whether they were "right, wrong or indifferent," they "seriously believed" there were problems with the election, the judge said. "I believe they were executing their constitutional right to seek redress," Simmons said. Each member of the group, which included a few high profile members of the Republican Party in Michigan, faced eight charges of forgery and conspiracy to commit election forgery. The top felony charges carried a maximum penalty of 14 years in prison. AP

SEAWALLS AND MANGROVES TO PROTECT JAVA

A new plan will integrate seawall construction with mangrove restoration along Java's northern coast to shield communities from environmental hazards, officials said. Coordinating Minister Agus Harimurti Yudhoyono explained that President Prabowo Subianto called for a combined approach, using seawalls in areas with severe land subsidence and mangroves where the geography is more stable. The initiative aims to shield residents and key industrial zones along the Pantura coast from flooding and land loss.

THAILAND

THAKSIN TO SERVE 1-YEAR JAIL TERM

Supreme Court ruled that former Prime Minister Thaksin Shinawatra must return to prison to serve a one-year sentence in the "14th floor" corruption case. Thaksin had been released under special parole and treated at Police Hospital, but the court dismissed claims about his medical condition and royal pardon, stating he had not served time in prison. The ruling resets his sentence from the beginning. Thaksin arrived at the SC under heavy security, accompanied by his lawyer and daughters, and was immediately provided inmate clothing following the verdict.

MALAYSIA

TWO PLEAD GUILTY IN BULLYING CASE

Two 17-year-old students pleaded guilty to injuring a classmate at a vocational college. They punched and kicked the victim in a hostel corridor. Magistrate Sharifah Amirda allowed bail of RM500 each and set October 1 for character reports and sentencing under Section 323 of the Penal Code.

Graft under Oli's watch as prime minister was his nemesis

KATHMANDU

VETERAN politician K P Sharma Oli, who wrecked many governments in the past, kindled hopes for much-needed political stability in Nepal when he assumed power for the third time in 2024, but that proved to be short-lived due to his own actions.

Known for his pro-China stance, Oli was forced to resign in the face of massive protests by youths over corruption and a government ban on social media that resulted in the death of at least 19 people in police firing and injuries to hundreds.

The 73-year-old leader's ouster has once again pushed Nepal, which has had 14 governments in the last 17 years, into political instability.

He came to power in July 2024 after he ditched his one-time friend Pushpa Kamal Dahal 'Prachanda' and joined hands with his foe-turned-friend Sher Bahadur Deuba, who was leading the largest party - Nepali Congress - in the House of Representatives. Oli, chairman of CPN-UML, defended breaking with 'Prachanda' to ally with the Nepali Congress, calling it key for stability and development. PTI

ICC holds in-absentia hearing for fugitive Kony

THE HAGUE: The International Criminal Court began its first-ever in absentia hearing on Tuesday against Joseph Kony, fugitive leader of Uganda's Lord's Resistance Army. Facing 39 counts of war crimes and crimes against humanity, Kony is accused of terrorizing northern Uganda and neighbouring countries for decades, including using child soldiers and mutilating civilians. Prosecutors presented graphic evidence of his crimes, while defense lawyers argued the hearing fair trial rights.

Russian glide bomb kills 24 pensioners in Ukraine village

DONETSK REGION

A Russian glide bomb struck a village in eastern Ukraine on Tuesday as people stood in line in the open air to collect their monthly pension. The blast killed at least 24 people and injured 19 others, the Ukraine Emergency Service said.

The bomb hit the Donetsk region village of Yarova at around 11 a.m. local time, authorities said. The village lies less than 10 kilometers (6 miles) from the front line. Donetsk regional head Vadym Filashkin said 23 of the dead were pensioners.

Yarova resident Hennadii Trush said his wife was killed in the blast as she waited to collect the pension of her bedridden mother-in-law. Afterward, Trush fled Yarova with his elderly mother, who was carried out on a stretcher.

In shock and with soot still on his face, Trush wept as he described the scene of the attack. "It was beyond words," he told The Associated Press. "Before, strikes landed on the outskirts. This time it was right in the center of the village." It was the latest Russian attack to kill civilians.

More than 12,000 Ukrainian civilians have been killed in the three-year war, the United Nations says. "Frankly brutal," Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy said in a post on Telegram of Tuesday's attack, urging the international community to make Russia pay economically for its full-scale invasion through additional sanctions.
