Delimitation defeat only a half win: Udhaya

DEPUTY Chief Minister Udhayanidhi Stalin on Saturday said the defeat of the proposed delimitation exercise was only a 'half victory' and that the 'full victory' would be achieved when people endorse the DMK alliance in the upcoming election.

Campaigning for alliance candidates in Tiruchengode, Rasipuram, Sankaragiri and Veerapandi constituencies across Salem and Namakkal districts, he said, "The delimitation move has been defeated in Parliament. This is only a partial victory for us. The rest will be ensured when people vote for the DMK alliance and deliver

the mandate on May 4."

Referring to the recent protest led by Chief Minister MK Stalin, he said it was in Namakkal that Stalin had burnt a copy of the delimitation proposal and hoisted black flags against it. "Today, that effort has yielded results with the bill being defeated," he said. Udhayanidhi further said that while the DMK alliance, under the leadership of Stalin, was the first in the country to oppose the delimitation move. He noted that a meeting of chief ministers from various States was convened in Chennai to build a united stand against the proposal. "Those ef-

orts have led to this outcome, and national leaders are now looking towards our chief minister," he said.

Criticising AIADMK general secretary Edappadi K Palaniswami, he alleged that the opposition leader had supported the delimitation proposal. "He continues to act in line with what the BJP says," he claimed.

Speaking in Salem, he said that while the DMK alliance had not performed well in the district previously, winning only one out of 11 constituencies, the party was confident of reversing the outcome. "This election will show

that Salem is a stronghold of the DMK," he said.

Responding to Palaniswami's criticism that the DMK government had not implemented welfare measures for farmers, Udhayanidhi termed the charge as false. He said it was the AIADMK that supported the farm laws introduced by the centre despite widespread protests by farmers. "The DMK has consistently stood with farmers. It was under Kalaingar Karunanidhi that free electricity for farmers was introduced, and under the present government, a separate budget for agriculture has been brought," he said.

He also accused the opposition of siding with the centre and ignoring the interests of the state.

'DMK stopping centre's benefits from reaching all'

OVER 1.82 lakh farmers in Dharmapuri and Krishnagiri districts have been denied the benefits of the PM-KISAN scheme because of the DMK government, said former BJP state president K Annamalai said during his campaigning in Dharmapuri and Krishnagiri.

During his campaigning in Dharmapuri, Annamalai said, "In the 2021 Assembly election, the DMK suffered a washout in Dharmapuri and Coimbatore. In a bid to exact revenge, they have stopped all development activities."

Lashing out at Stalin, he said, "Stalin went to Kerala five times, but has done nothing; he could have resolved many water management issues between the two states." Speaking in Kelamangalam in Krishnagiri, Annamalai assured that the airport and metro train extension will be brought to Hosur.

"50% of mobile phone are manufactured in Tamil Nadu, of which 50% are from Krishnagiri district. The BJP government brought Tata Electronics Private Limited to Krishnagiri district to manufacture mobile phone accessories, by which over thousands of people received job opportunities." He urged people to vote for Thalli BJP candidate Dr C Nagesh Kumar.

Speed breakers on Hosur road repainted after repeated pleas

FOLLOWING continuous demands by the public, the State Highways Department has started painting speed breakers on the Hosur-Denkanikottai road on Saturday. Three speed breakers between Hosur and Denkanikottai near Hosur were repainted to reduce accidents. A pharmacist near Navathi bus stop told *TNIE*, "After months of demand, a speed breaker was painted only a few months before, but the paint has faded. It was painted again on Saturday. Similarly, a speed breaker was re-painted near Midugara-

palli." M Sasikumar (42), a private company employee who regularly travels from Hosur to Denkanikottai said, "Due to the poor visibility of the speed breakers, more accidents were reported between Hosur railway station road and Mathigiri junction road. This sort of periodical maintenance must be done without any demands."

"CM MK Stalin is scheduled to visit Hosur on Sunday, so this could also be a reason why the speed breakers have been painted." A State Highways Department official told *TNIE* that, "This is regular maintenance, not necessitated due to the CM's visit."

'DMK-AIADMK in cahoots over Kodanad case'

VK Sasikala, General Secretary of All India Puratchi Thalaivar Makkal Munnetra Kazhagam (AIPTMMK) on Saturday alleged an 'understanding' between the DMK and the AIADMK over the handling of the Kodanad heist-murder case, claiming that neither party had pursued the case seriously despite multiple

developments.

Campaigning in Edappadi constituency, Sasikala said the Kodanad incident took place within months of her being sent to prison after she had facilitated Edappadi K Palaniswami becoming chief minister.

"While he was the Chief Minister, intruders entered the Kodanad estate. A security guard who had served there for more than

four decades was murdered, and later, several others, including a driver, died under mysterious circumstances, almost like scenes from a cinema. However, the AIADMK government did not properly investigate the case. Even after the DMK came to power, they did not speak about it. This shows there is an understanding between the two parties," she said.

DMK functionaries booked for violating MCC in Adhi

DHARMAPURI: DMK functionaries were booked for violating the Model Code of Conduct in Adhiyamankottai and Dharmapuri. A vehicle belonging to P Mallamuthu, the DMK block secretary (South) from Kammappatti, was stopped by a flying squad along the Dharmapuri-Salem road near Adhiyamankottai. The team led by M Periyannan, sub registrar of the cooperative department, found over 217 calendars, 300 Illatharasi coupons and party flags belonging to the Congress, VCK, and DMKD. As it was a clear violation of the MCC, a case was registered against Mallamuthu. Similarly, in Dharmapuri, the static surveillance team led by C Nehru stopped a vehicle, and found three people transporting over 1,444 DMK calendars, 42 bundles of Illatharasi coupons, and party propaganda materials. A case was registered against DMK organiser from Pappireddipatti Sooriya, driver Sathya and Karthi from Dharmapuri.

14-year-old kills self at home in Namakkal

NAMAKKAL: A 14-year-old girl allegedly died by suicide at her residence in Namakkal on Friday. The student, a resident of Kollampattarai, was a Class 9 student at the Government Girls Higher Secondary School, Namakkal. According to police, her mother, Madhewari (32), who runs a tiffin shop near the Namakkal New Bus Stand, had left home around 4.15 am, as part of her daily routine. Upon her return at around 10 pm, she found the door locked. Upon entering the house, she discovered that her daughter had died by suicide, said police. Preliminary inquiry revealed that the girl had been using a mobile phone without her mother's knowledge. Her mother had come to know about it and warned her a few days ago. Police sources said all angles are being examined, and further investigation is under way in the case.
