



STATE READY TO BE NORWAY'S PREFERRED PARTNER: SRIDHAR

IT & Industries Minister D Sridhar Babu has invited Norwegian companies to explore investment opportunities across key sectors, including life sciences, healthcare, clean energy and emerging technologies, in Telangana.

On Tuesday, he met with a high-level Norwegian delegation led by the Ambassador of Norway to India, May-Elin Stener, at the Secretariat and urged them to establish industries in Telangana. "Telangana is ready to be Norway's preferred partner in India for these sectors," he said.

Highlighting the state government's initiatives to promote industrial growth, he called on Norwegian firms to leverage the state's growing innovation and industrial ecosystem. Sridhar noted that Norway has established itself as a global leader in clean energy, sustainable infrastructure, electric mobility, offshore wind and green manufacturing and proposed closer collaboration in these areas, like AI, cybersecurity, green hydrogen, battery technology, industrial decarbonisation and digital health.

BULLIED AT WORK Woman cop ends life, names colleague in note

A 33-year-old woman police constable, Sangeetha, died by suicide at her residence in the Gopal Swamy temple area under Matwada police station limits on Tuesday night. A three-page suicide note recovered from the scene alleges harassment by a male colleague, constable Sridhar.

Sangeetha was posted at the women's police station in Jayashankar Bhupalpalay district and was staying with her in-laws in Warangal city. Her husband works at a local bank.

According to Matwada Inspector N Karunakar, police received information from neighbours about the incident and rushed to the spot. During the preliminary inquiry, clues teams recovered a three-page suicide note, which has been handed over to the investigating team.

In the note, Sangeetha alleged that constable Sridhar had been harassing and threatening her. Matwada police are verifying these allegations in coordination with Bhupalpalay women's police station.

The body has been shifted to the Mahatma Gandhi Memorial Hospital (MGM), Warangal, for postmortem. Police said the investigation is underway based on the contents of the suicide note.

Man dies, partner critical after taking poison

A 20-year-old degree student died while his 19-year-old partner is battling for life after the couple allegedly consumed pesticide in a forest area between Tadvai and Eturunagaram on Monday evening, following opposition from their families to their marriage.

The victim was identified as M Satish, a third-year degree student from Krishnapuram village in Wazeedu mandal of Mulugu district. The woman, D

Parents reject marriage bid

According to police, the couple had been in a relationship and

had sought their parents' consent to marry, but both families refused. Distressed, they decided to end their lives. On Monday evening, they went into the forest with pesticide bottles and allegedly consumed the poison. Satish died on the spot, while Ravithrayani managed to reach the roadside, cried for help and collapsed.

Passersby noticed her unconscious and foaming at the mouth and alerted the Eturu-

nagaram police. Sub-inspector B Mahesh and his team rushed to the spot and shifted her to a Community Health Centre, from where she was referred to MGM Hospital.

Before being shifted, Ravithrayani informed the police about the incident. Based on her statement, police traced Satish's body in the forest and shifted it for postmortem.

A case has been registered and investigation is underway. Ravithrayani's condition remains critical, police said.

BRS stages rasta roko over delayed procurement

Adilabad: Demanding the resumption of Bengal gram procurement, BRS leaders and activists staged a rasta roko on the interstate road at Jainath on Tuesday. Leaders alleged that although officials had issued village-wise procurement dates till April 30, purchases were stopped midway, causing hardship to farmers. They said only 24,000 quintals were procured before the process halted. In Jainath mandal, procurement has been completed in few of the 18 gram panchayats.

Minister sets 10-day deadline for paddy purchase

Nalgonda: R&B Minister Komatireddy Venkat Reddy on Tuesday directed officials to complete Rabi grain procurement in the district on a war footing within 10 days. At a review meeting, he instructed officials to deploy adequate lorries to all procurement centres and ensure round-the-clock operations with proper lighting. Basic amenities such as shade and drinking water must be provided to farmers, and there should be no shortage of gunny bags or labour, he added.

Man loses ₹1.5 lakh in phishing scam

Kamareddy: A man from Gollapally allegedly lost ₹1.5 lakh while attempting to purchase a smart phone online. Police said the victim, Javid Ali, was searching for an iPhone. Clicking one of the links on the browser, he was redirected to a different site where he paid ₹1.5 lakh. After he did not get any confirmation text message from the site, he realised that he had been scammed. He immediately approached the police and lodged his complaint. Police have registered a case.

Man kills father in row over money for liquor

A man was allegedly killed by his 18-year-old son after an argument over money for liquor in Eidgh Colony on Tuesday.

According to police, the victim, Syed Jaber, worked as a lorry cleaner. He had recently become addicted to liquor and stopped working. He frequently demanded money from his children and allegedly harassed them. On Tuesday morning, a quarrel broke out over money, during which the accused allegedly struck Jaber on the head with a brick, killing him on the spot.

Police shifted the body for a postmortem and took the accused into custody. A case has been registered.
