



Ottapalam landslide was a natural occurrence, not negligence: Officials

Nearly 80% of work is completed | Deck slab work expected to be finished by end of May

CONSTRUCTION of the East Ottapalam parallel bridge is progressing at a fast pace, with officials confirming that the recent soil erosion near the existing bridge was an unexpected natural occurrence and not due to any negligence or flaw in construction.

The recent landslide occurred on April 25 after PCC work for the retaining wall foundation had been completed. Soil was being removed using machinery to facilitate retaining wall construction, leading to temporary traffic restrictions. Authorities have promised that the retaining wall will be completed within 10 days, after which traffic will return to normalcy.

Retaining wall to be completed in 10 days

The landslide occurred on April 25 after PCC work for the retaining wall foundation had been completed. Soil was being removed using machinery to facilitate retaining wall construction. Authorities promised the retaining wall will be completed within 10 days, after which traffic will return to normalcy. They also said similar soil erosion had occurred during last year's monsoon, which was temporarily addressed using sheet piling to maintain traffic.

Authorities said that similar soil erosion had occurred on both sides of the existing bridge during last year's monsoon, which was temporarily addressed using sheet piling to maintain traffic movement.

At present, nearly 80% of the construction has been completed, and the deck slab work is expected to be finished by the end of May.



Dismissal of misinformation, officials emphasised that the existing bridge, built in 1965, remains structurally sound. Unlike typical projects, the new bridge is being constructed alongside the old one without dismantling it. They also promised the project will be completed within the stipulated timeframe and opened to the public soon, easing congestion in the region.

The project began on February 21, 2024, when the agreement was signed and the site was handed over to the contractor on the same day. Foundation work had commenced soon after, but heavy rains in May 2024 caused the ring bund to collapse, forcing a temporary halt to construction.

Due to strong water flow in the eastern canal, work could only resume in December 2024.

A traffic regulatory committee meeting was held at Ottapalam municipality to address temporary traffic disruptions, and necessary measures have been initiated. Municipal chairperson M K Jayasudha and Vice-chairperson K Rajesh visited the site and issued directives to ensure smooth progress.

Strict arrangements in place for vote counting in Palakkad

COUNTING OF votes for the assembly elections at all 12 constituencies in the district will begin at 8 am on Monday at three designated centres — Government Victoria College, Palakkad; NSS Engineering College, Akathethara and Mount Seena Public School, Pathiripala.

Strong rooms storing electronic voting machines (EVMs) will be opened at 7.30 am in the presence of candidates and their agents. Counting will begin with postal ballots, followed by votes recorded in EVMs.

The process will be conducted under the supervision of observers appointed by the Election Commission, in the presence of candidates and their agents. Micro-observers and assistant returning officers have also been deployed. The EVMs are currently kept under round-the-clock security at the three centres. The voters' mandate is expected to become clear by around 11 am.

Fireworks manufacture, sale and use banned



District Collector M S Madhavikutty has imposed strict restrictions on the manufacture and sale of fireworks in view of the vote counting and result declaration on Monday. The restrictions will be in force from May 3 to May 5. The order has been issued under BNSS Section 163, citing the need to safeguard public safety and maintain a peaceful atmosphere during the counting period.

As per the order, all licensed fireworks manufacturing and sales units in the district must remain completely closed on these days. The sale, storage, or transfer of fireworks is strictly prohibited during this period. Bursting of fireworks as part of victory celebrations or any public events is also banned. Tahsildars and SHOs have been directed to ensure compliance with the order within their respective jurisdictions.

venues. Only returning officers will be allowed to carry mobile phones inside counting halls. Special counters will be set up at entry points for other officials to deposit their phones.

A total of 61 tables have been arranged for counting postal ballots, 203 tables for EVM counting, and 13 tables for counting votes received through the Electronically Transmitted Postal Ballot System, which is used by service voters. A total of 30 counting halls have been

set up across the three centres.

Heavy security has been deployed under the supervision of the district police chief. Around 2,150 police personnel have been assigned for duty at counting centres and for patrolling across the district. Nearly 100 central force personnel are also guarding strong rooms.

Police surveillance will be in place at entry points, counting halls, surrounding areas, and parking zones.

Lightning strike damages house; three injured

GURUVAYUR: Three members of a family suffered injuries after a portion of the concrete roof of their house collapsed following a lightning strike at Manathala in Chavakkad on Saturday. The injured are Manoj, 42, his wife Smithi, 34, a former municipal councillor, and their daughter Dhvani, 7. All three also suffered burns and were admitted to a private hospital in Chavakkad. Family members said a loud thunderclap was first heard, followed by electrical appliances in the house malfunctioning and burning out. Later, a powerful lightning strike caused parts of the roof to cave in.

60 sub-inspectors join Kerala police after passing-out parade in Thrissur

A TOTAL OF 60 sub-inspector trainees of the 32-A batch have officially joined the Kerala Police force after successfully completing their training at the police academy in Thrissur. The passing-out parade was held at the academy's main parade ground in a formal ceremony attended by senior police officials.

Chief guest Ravada A Chandrasekhar, state police chief, received the salute from the cadets. Academy director Sethuraman and other senior

officers were also present. During the ceremony, outstanding performers were honoured with trophies by the state police chief. M P Navaneeth was adjudged best outdoor cadet and best shooter, while K P Keerthana won the best indoor cadet award. The best all-round cadet title was awarded to Basil Paul.

The training for the batch began on April 3, 2025. The outdoor curriculum included parade drills, physical fitness, shield and lathi drill, ceremonial drill, mob operations, obstacle course, field craft, map

reading, bomb detection and disposal, karate, yoga, swimming, and driving. Advanced weapons training was also provided, including handling of AK-47, INSAS, SLR, LMG, Glock pistols, carbines...

The batch comprises 47 men and 13 women. Many trainees are highly qualified, with 12 post-graduates, 25 graduates, and others with professional qualifications like MBA, MTech, and BTech. The training aimed at enhancing competence and public-friendly policing in line with the force's motto, 'Soft in manner, firm in action'.

'Only devotees aged 70 eligible for senior citizen darshan'

THE Guruvayur Devaswam has decided to revise the age criteria for senior citizens availing special darshan facilities at Guruvayur temple. As per the new decision, only devotees aged 70 and above will be considered senior citizens. Earlier, those aged 60 and above were eligible for the senior citizens' darshan queue. From now on, only devotees above 70 will be categorised as "super seniors."

The decision has triggered discussions, especially among regular temple visitors and local representatives. Meanwhile, the devaswam has taken steps to ease congestion faced by devotees by increasing the number of offering (vazhipadu) counters. One additional counter each has been set up along the southern side of the temple complex for issuing vazhipadu receipts and at the western entrance for distributing prasadam.

To improve efficiency, security personnel have been assigned duties at the vazhipadu counters along with clerical staff. Devotees had earlier complained about long waiting time for booking of offerings and collecting prasadam, often extending up to an hour, particularly on public holidays.

However, the decision to raise the senior citizen age limit has faced criticism. Councillor Shobha Hari Narayanan has demanded that the devaswam withdraw the decision. She said the retirement age in many sectors is 55, while old-age pension eligibility begins at 60. "In such a context, how can the devaswam re-define senior citizens as those above 70?"
