# G SUDHAKARAN WARNED OVER REMARKS AGAINST CPM WORKERS

Area secretary has warned of strong reactions and protests if such behaviour continues

CPM Ambalapuzha area committee has issued a warning to MLA G Sudhakaran, urging him to stop making derogatory remarks against party workers during public functions.

In a statement, the committee alleged that Sudhakaran has been using public platforms to criticise and insult CPM workers. The committee said that during a recent school reopening function, the MLA deliberately made remarks targeting party activists who serve

as members of School Management Committees in various schools. According to the CPM, instead of pointing out any shortcomings in his role as an MLA, Sudhakaran has been repeatedly attacking party workers through public speeches. The



committee said these remarks are politically motivated and based on information received from others, describing such comments as undemocratic. The statement further said that introducing political disputes into non-political public

events diminishes the dignity of such platforms, where people of different political beliefs are present. The CPM accused Sudhakaran of making misleading statements merely to win applause from Congress supporters.

CPM area secretary C Shamji said that if the MLA continues to make political speeches and attack party workers at public functions, strong reactions may arise from those attending the same events. He added that such irresponsible remarks would face strong protests in the future.

# With ports dept takeover, Kottayam port sets its eyes on Vizhinjam link

IN A MAJOR breakthrough after its establishment, the administration of the Kottayam Port and Container Terminal (KPACT), India's first Inland Container Depot, has been transferred from the industries department to the ports department. This move aligns with the blue economy initiatives announced by the V D Satheesan-led government.

The transfer process is set to complete with the formation of a new board, chaired by the head of the Kerala Maritime Board, under the ports department. With this, Kottayam port will become the 18th port under the board. Previously, the administration of the Kottayam port was managed by the Kerala Industrial Infrastructure Development Corporation under the industries department, with KINFRA holding 49% stake in the port.

The transfer of Kerala's only inland port, a longstanding demand of the port authorities since its inception in 2012, gained momentum following the Union government's directive to integrate all ports across the country under the respective maritime departments.

A key advantage of this transfer is that Kottayam port can now access infrastructure development funds from the Sagarmala programme of the Union government, which aims to improve logistics efficiency, reduce transportation costs, and support trade by increasing the use of coastal shipping and inland waterways.

"Since the port was under the industries department, benefits of port-related activities were not fully available. However, it can now apply for funds under the Sagarmala project, as applications must be submitted through the Maritime Board. With the transfer of control to the ports department, we can submit projects

Kottayam has consistently demonstrated strong performance in container transactions and ranks among the highest in container movement within the state," Roopesh added.

Recently, the port received the Emerging Inland Container Depot Award of the Kochi port for the inland port that handled the highest cargo movements in the last financial year.

## The way ahead

Kottayam port authorities are now looking forward to the elevation of Vizhinjam as a gateway port, which is expected to significantly boost container transactions from Kottayam.

Currently, the port handles approximately 300 containers a month. Authorities anticipate this number could double once the port is connected to Vizhinjam. A market survey conducted by the port authorities revealed that exporters from the eastern side of Ernakulam, such as Muvattupuzha, as well as those in Idukki and Pathanamthitta, currently use Kochi port. However, they are likely to shift their transactions to Kottayam once the connection to Vizhinjam is established.

"At the same time, we need to enhance our infrastructure facilities that include adding seariver barges, crane units etc. Additionally, the Inland Water Authority of India should ensure connectivity by developing a water route to access sea waters," Roopesh said.

### NDRF team visits flood-prone areas in Tiruvalla

Pathanamthitta: A team from the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) visited flood-prone areas in Tiruvalla and assessed the situation in vulnerable regions. The team inspected the banks of the Manimala River in Peringara village and the Pampa River in Niranam village. The NDRF personnel also visited schools identified as potential relief camps, including St John's LPS, Mepral, MDLP School, Niranam West, and St Mary's UPS, Kadapra.

### Man barges into court, attempts to attack munsiff

Alappuzha: A man allegedly barged into the chamber of the Munsiff judge at Chengannur Munsiff Court on Wednesday and attempted to attack her, leaving two court employees injured during efforts to restrain him. The incident occurred around 10 am when Arun Mohan of Peringala, Chengannur, entered the chamber of Munsiff Amala Lawrence in a helmet and a raincoat. Police have taken Arun into custody and are investigating further.

### Stray dog attack in Kayamkulam: 8 hurt

Alappuzha: A stray dog attack in Kayamkulam on Wednesday left around eight people, including students, injured. The incident occurred around 9 am near Aikya Junction, north of Kayamkulam town. Three of the victims, who suffered serious injuries, were shifted to the Government Medical College Hospital in Vandanam for treatment. The remaining injured persons received treatment at Kayamkulam Taluk Hospital.

### Ootha fishing banned in breeding season

Pathanamthitta: The fisheries department has prohibited "Ootha" fishing and other illegal fishing practices that interfere with fish breeding activities in inland water bodies. Assistant director of fisheries said that catching fish by blocking their migratory routes in paddy fields, streams and canals during the breeding season, as well as using unauthorised fishing equipment, is strictly prohibited.

### 24-hour control room to be set up in P'Thitta

Pathanamthitta: A meeting of officials from various departments was held to coordinate disaster management and monsoon preparedness activities in Pathanamthitta municipality on Wednesday. The meeting decided to establish a 24-hour control room to deal with emergencies during the monsoon season. Residents can contact the control room in case of accidents or disaster-related situations.

# Govt to initiate spl plans to resolve traffic snarls in Ktm

TO address the traffic woes in Kottayam town and surrounding areas, the government is set to develop specialised plans and schemes.

A decision in this effect was taken in a meeting convened by Speaker Thiruvanchoor Radhakrishnan in Kottayam on Monday. According to authorities, these plans will encompass both immediate restructuring and long-term implementation strategies.

In the first phase, a report will be prepared outlining steps to be taken to ensure laws and regulations are strictly followed in the town. For this, a committee comprising the district collector, district police chief, regional transport officer, public works (roads) executive engineer, representatives of KSEB, National Highways Authority of India and Kottayam municipality has been constituted.

A long-term plan will be prepared keeping in view the development of the town and nearby areas. NATPAC will conducting a study and submitting a report

The committee will conduct a study on issues such as illegal parking, encroachments, law violations, bus stop arrangements and details of auto stands.

The speaker announced that a final decision on subsequent actions will be made after detailed discussions on the draft report submitted by this committee by June 13. "A long-term plan for traffic reform will be prepared keeping in view the development of the town and the surrounding areas. NATPAC will be tasked with conducting a detailed study for this and submitting a report. Future traffic development will be implemented on the basis of this report," he said.

# Court raises questions over new charge

THE Alappuzha District and Sessions Court on Wednesday raised questions over the Special Investigation Team's (SIT) decision to invoke the charge of attempt to murder in the case relating to the alleged assault on Youth Congress workers by gunmen of former chief minister Pinarayi Vijayan during the Nava Kerala Yatra.

During the hearing of the anticipatory bail pleas filed by the accused gunmen, the court observed that the attempt to murder charge appeared to have been added without adequate examination and sought clarification on the SIT's intention.

Emphasising the importance of visual evidence, the court summoned the investigating officer for an explanation.

# Cattle shortage: Meat shops in 4 dists to shut ops this weekend

MEAT SHOPS in Pathanamthitta, Kottayam, Idukki and Alappuzha districts will be closed on Saturday and Sunday as the Meat Industries Welfare Association (MIWA) looks to draw public attention to the severe cattle shortage and the growing transportation challenges faced by ordinary traders.

MIWA leaders said the meat sector, which provides livelihoods to an estimated 15 lakh people in Kerala, is facing an unprecedented crisis due to disruptions in the cattle trade. Kerala depends largely on cattle brought

from other states to meet its demand for beef.

Addressing a press conference on Wednesday, the leaders alleged that cattle transported legally were being subjected to illegal seizures in the name of religious sentiments and other objections.

Also, confusion arising from changes in the health certification process in Andhra Pradesh, a major source of cattle, has contributed to transport difficulties and disruptions in the livestock trade, the leaders said. Health certificates are mandatory for transporting cattle. MIWA leaders alleged

that ordinary traders are facing severe hardships while cattle controlled by influential groups move more freely. As a result, cattle trade in many interior regions has nearly come to a standstill, affecting meat availability in Kerala, they said.

Leaders also expressed concern over the long-term impact on livestock farmers. Unlike poultry and goats, which can be raised for market within months, cattle require several years to reach market weight. They said market uncertainties are discouraging farmers from continuing in the sector.
