

Live-in partner's kid dies mysteriously, realtor held

Woman, an advocate, goes missing, gives different versions for death

A 47-year-old private school owner from Davanagere filed a police complaint, blaming his wife and her live-in partner for the mysterious death of his five-and-a-half-year-old daughter. The woman, who has filed for divorce, was staying with her live-in partner and the child at a villa in Bengaluru. On March 25, the woman's brother called the school owner, B Praveen, and informed him about the girl's death. Praveen, who grew suspicious, sent a copy of the child's post-mortem report to his sister, who is a doctor in England, asking her opinion. The doctor suspected foul play in the girl's death, prompting Praveen, who is from Harihar in Davanagere, to file the complaint at the Kadugodi police station on Thursday. In the complaint, he has named his 44-year-old wife, an advocate, and her 40-year-old

live-in partner Mohan G Mahalingappa, a land developer, for the death of his daughter, P Venella. She died on March 24. The woman was staying with Mohan and Venella at a villa in Seegehalli in Kadugodi. Their other daughter, who is 17 years old, stays with Praveen.



"The live-in partner, Mohan, was arrested and is being questioned, while the search is on for the victim's mother," said a police officer.

In his complaint, Praveen stated that his wife met her college friend and former boyfriend Mohan in November 2025 when she was in Bengaluru handling a land dispute. She became close to Mohan over time and forced Praveen to sign the divorce papers. The woman told her brother that around 11 pm on March 24, she ordered biryani and fed it to the child. In the morning, she found the child dead. She also allegedly gave another version, where she said that

she and Mohan had gone to a restaurant in Kolar to celebrate her birthday. Before that, they had given Vennela ice cream and left the child sleeping inside the car with the air conditioner on, even as they went into the restaurant. Later, they took the child home and put her to bed, but found her dead the next morning. Praveen's sister, who is a paediatric specialist practising in England, told him that the wife and her live-in partner might have done something to the child that may have caused the death.

Praveen stated in his complaint that his wife and her boyfriend might have considered the child an obstacle in their relationship and eliminated her. He alleged that the two have kicked the child in the stomach and suffocated her to death. To conceal their crime, they later admitted the child to a hospital, he added. A case of murder and disappearance of evidence has been registered against the accused, the police said.

3 drunks steal from supermarket, 1 held

A gang of three miscreants under the influence of alcohol entered a supermarket posing as customers and committed robbery on Banerghatta Road in Arekere. The accused threatened

the cashier at knifepoint and attacked a staff member who tried to prevent them from fleeing.

The cashier and staff screamed for help. Passersby managed to chase and nab one of the accused. The incident occurred at 10 pm during the closing hours on Friday. The

three accused filled two shopping trolleys with groceries in the supermarket. The accused also kept some items inside their pants.

The cashier who observed this on the CCTV monitor warned the accused. The trio rushed towards the cashier, threatened to attack him by

showing him a weapon.

The accused, who was nabbed and handed over to the police, is Faizal (21) from Thilaknagar.

The other two escaped accused are also from the same area. A case of robbery is registered against the accused by the Puttenahalli police.

₹4L gold chain snatched from septuagenarian

BENGALURU: A 73-year-old woman who was on her evening walk was robbed of her 32 gm gold chain by two bike-borne miscreants. The incident occurred at 4 pm on Friday on OB Chudahalli Road in Uttarahalli. The victim, Rathnavathi, is a resident of OB Chudahalli. The accused came in front of her on a bike, snatched her chain worth about Rs 4 lakh and fled. "The man riding the pillion snatched her chain. The victim was alone at the spot at the time of incident. The details of the accused are unknown," said an officer. The Kaggalipura police in Bengaluru South district have registered a case of robbery against the accused duo. Rathnavathi from Kundapura has been living in the city for the last five years. ENS

Exercise should be regular: treks, expeditions a reward, says climber

WITH increasing cases of people, particularly techies and teens, complaining of early osteoarthritis, experts and doctors ask youth to exercise regularly and look at trekking and expeditions as a reward.

Sidharth Uniyal, known as BadKneesGuru, was promoting this. He successfully completed four Himalayan peaks above 6,000 metres in five days

in May 2026, in collaboration with the Bengaluru-based adventure firm, TrekNomads. He summited Nirekha Peak (6,159m), Lobuche Peak (6,119m), Island Peak (6,189m) and Mera Peak (6,476m).

Uniyal, who has suffered knee injuries and undergone three critical knee surgeries, said youth look at treks and expeditions as an adventure, but that should not be the case. Exercising at least 3-4 times a

week helps improve fitness, he said. The reason why Uniyal is inspiring others is that he had undergone three ACL (anterior cruciate ligament) surgeries, suffered serious meniscus and cartilage damage and currently functions without an ACL in his left knee. Also, just 15 days before the expedition, he twisted his knee again. He is also the founder of Granimals, a global injury recovery and performance platform.
